

SSWAA ACTION ALERT Build Back Better Act

BACKGROUND: Congress continues to negotiate the Build Back Better Act, their major multi-trillion dollar social spending budget reconciliation package which includes funding for a wide range of key Democratic priorities such as climate change, labor and workforce development, Medicaid, higher education, and employment benefits. With narrow margins in the Senate, key provisions for children and families could be cut. SSWAA has reached out to Congress to ask for additional funding to help families across this country, but now we need you to take action as well. Please write your Congressional delegation and urge them to include funding for programs that benefit children and families and higher education affordability.

PROPOSAL HIGHLIGHTS:

- Higher education affordability:
 - Maximum Pell Grant award increase of \$550.
 - Expansion of federal financial aid to eligible students with DACA, TPS, and DED status.
 - Grant programs to help train new teachers and address the teacher shortage, with a specific focus on special education teachers.
 - Targeted funding for HBCUs, TCUs, HSIs, and MSIs.
- Free, universal preschool for all 3- and 4-year-olds.
- \$10 billion for child nutrition programs, including expanded eligibility for free school meals and provision of Summer EBT benefits to eligible low-income children.
- Extension of the Child Tax Credit program into 2022.
- Affordable housing construction, rehabilitation, and improvement.
